




## Local Planning Committee (LPC)

Please inform the LPC co-chairs during the meeting if the need to disclose a conflict arises unexpectedly, and then recuse yourself from discussion or voting on the project.


As we continue through the planning process, recusal forms will be required from anyone with an identified potential conflict to be kept on file with the Department of State.
















## Downtown Alexandria Bay Vision

### Project Updates Since LPC #4



#### **B09** Renovation of 20 Walton Street

- Submitted finalized cost estimates
- Clarified intended use of 1<sup>st</sup> floor will rent as a commercial space
- No floor plans or architectural drawings available at this time

#### **B18 Renovating 34 James Street**

- Submitted a detailed budget showing which items are requesting reimbursement and other funding sources available for the project
- Clarified intended use of 1<sup>st</sup> floor is to fit the space up for a future grab and go style restaurant
- Sponsor provided project renderings



### Preliminary Projects List from LPC #4



- 11 Projects Ready to Advance
- 16 Projects Not for NY Forward
- 3 Pipeline Projects
- \$6.6 Million in Requested Funds
- \$7.5 Million in Total Project Costs

- LPC to develop a slate of recommended projects for inclusion in the Strategic Investment Plan
- This slate of projects should represent a NYF request of between \$6 \$8 million







Pipeline/supporting are projects proposed in the NYF process that are great ideas but are not ready to receive NYF funding for a variety of reasons. For these projects, the LPC may elect to include these projects in the SIP as supporting or pipeline projects. While not recommended for NYF funding, these projects are consistent with the goals of NYF and the community's vision and the LPC would like to include them as potential areas for revitalization within the downtown.
